What is the Community Gynaecology Service?

The Community Gynaecology Service is a service commissioned by Barnet Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG).

A team of local Consultant Gynaecologists are working within primary care to provide a very responsive and efficient Gynaecology service.

The aim is to provide an exceptional quality community based NHS service that ensures that you will be seen by the right person in the right place first time for the management of your gynaecological problem.



How the service works

You will have been seen by your GP recently who has decided with you that you require specialist gynaecological input for your problem.

Your GP will send us a referral letter that will be assessed very quickly by our Triage Team. We will then contact you by letter to advise you of the next step. This may involve:

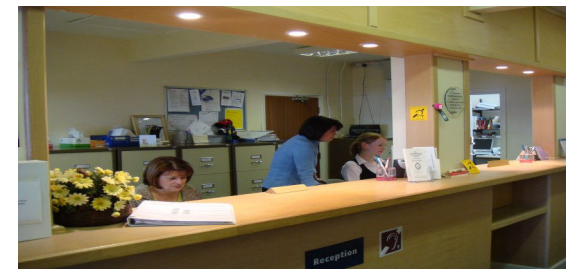
- Further advice to your GP with ideas of different treatment
- A consultation in a Community clinic with a Consultant Gynaecologist or GPSI
- Onward referral to an acute hospital clinic if appropriate

We will try to make your appointment in a clinic that is nearest to you but also with a consultant with a special interest in your condition. Therefore it is important that you try to keep the appointment date that is given to you.

If you cannot keep your appointment, please contact the service on **01727 823111 Mon - Fri 09:00-18:00**, so that it can be re-arranged.

Please arrive 5 minutes prior to your appointment time in order to complete a short medical history form. On arrival at the clinic, please report to Reception and let the receptionist know of your arrival.



If you fail to attend your appointment without letting us know beforehand, your GP will be informed and you will be discharged from the service.
